<u>THEME:</u> "Enhancing Indigenous Peoples' right to self-determination in the context of the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples: emphasizing the voices of Indigenous youth"

The theme of this year's Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues is once more broad-reaching, thus allowing for varied discussions over all areas which concern and affect Indigenous Peoples globally. As outcomes of the 22nd Session, new inclusions into the program of work include a discussion on the implementation of CEDAW General Recommendation No. 39, as well as a high-level event celebrating the 10th anniversary of the outcome document of the World Conference on Indigenous Peoples, which will take place in the afternoon session of 17.04.

With Indigenous Youth at the centre of this year's theme, we invite you to go over our summary report of the United Nations Global Indigenous Youth Forum (UNGIYF) which took place in October 2023, which undoubtedly will drive discussions.

This bibliography serves as a preparatory list of documents useful in informing delegates of major publications disseminated by Indigenous Peoples, our colleagues from other NGOs, as well as documents stemming from UN mechanisms.
